Puppy Information Sheet

“Heelersridge” is a registered kennel and operates under the code of ethics as set down by DogsNSW and the Australian National Kennel Club (ANKC).

Our puppies are raised with love and care and have been handled by us since birth. They have excellent drive, are guaranteed sound and be able to work to the best of ones ability to teach them. Kennel inspections by appointment are welcome.

We strive to produce healthy, problem free pups that are strong and true-to-type. Australian Cattle Dogs are not a dog to be left in the backyard all day – they crave to be with humans, and if left to their own devices they may become destructive & noisy. They need mental stimulation and regular exercise.

We produce two or three litters per year, we carefully research prospective stud dogs and only select those that compliment our bitches. All our breeding stock are tested for hereditary diseases and come from champion lines.

Australian Cattle Dogs are a loving family member that will follow you to the ends of the earth, protect you from threat, and die for you if you ask them to.

The above prices include care and housing up to 8weeks of age – extended stays, export requirements, additional vaccinations/veterinary requirements, or transport costs will incur additional charges.

The above prices include:

- ANKC Registration on the Limited Register (unless by prior arrangement)
- BAER testing at the University of Queensland (hearing)
- Confirmed status for prcd-PRA (tested or obligate)
- 1st Vaccination at 6 weeks of age
- 2nd Vaccination at 8 weeks of age
- Microchipping & Worming
- 24/7 Support for Life
- Puppy Pack & Book
- All documentation to support the above

A deposit of \$500.00 is required (overseas A\$100), and is transferable but non-refundable.

Unless by prior arrangement, all puppies are sold under contract to be spayed prior to 7mths of age.

We are happy to arrange transport for you, all freight costs will be at your expense and must be paid by you directly to the carriers. We have a very good working relationship with Dogtainers and would be happy to secure a quote on your behalf. In some cases pups traveling by air are required to have a veterinary certificate of health prior to flying – consultation is at the buyer's expense. Pups fly from Lismore Airport and transport to the airport from Heelersridge is included in the price.

Puppies sold to registered breeders, or persons purchasing a pup for the purpose of exhibiting it in a championship show, are sold on the condition that should the pup develop a major fault it is to be returned to us in exchange for a pup from our next litter. For this purpose, a major fault would be an incorrect bite, one or both ears not pricking, or a male puppy failing to produce one or both testicles.

Heelersridge adheres to the following conditions as set down by the Animal Welfare Code of Practice as issued by the NSW Government –

- Puppies cannot be sold until they are 8 weeks old
- Puppies cannot be sold or re-homed to persons under 18 years of age
- If within 3 days a puppy is not acceptable to the purchaser for any reason, the breeder is required to take the puppy back and refund 50% of the purchase price
- If within 7 days a puppy is not acceptable to the purchaser due to health reasons, excluding injury, and the complaint is supported by a veterinary practitioner, the breeder and the owner should negotiate in good faith to achieve an equitable outcome

Prospective buyers who have submitted an application, will be contacted when our next pregnancy is confirmed. A decision as to which applications have been successful will be made when the puppies have been assessed, and all applicants will be advised by email if they were successful or not.
